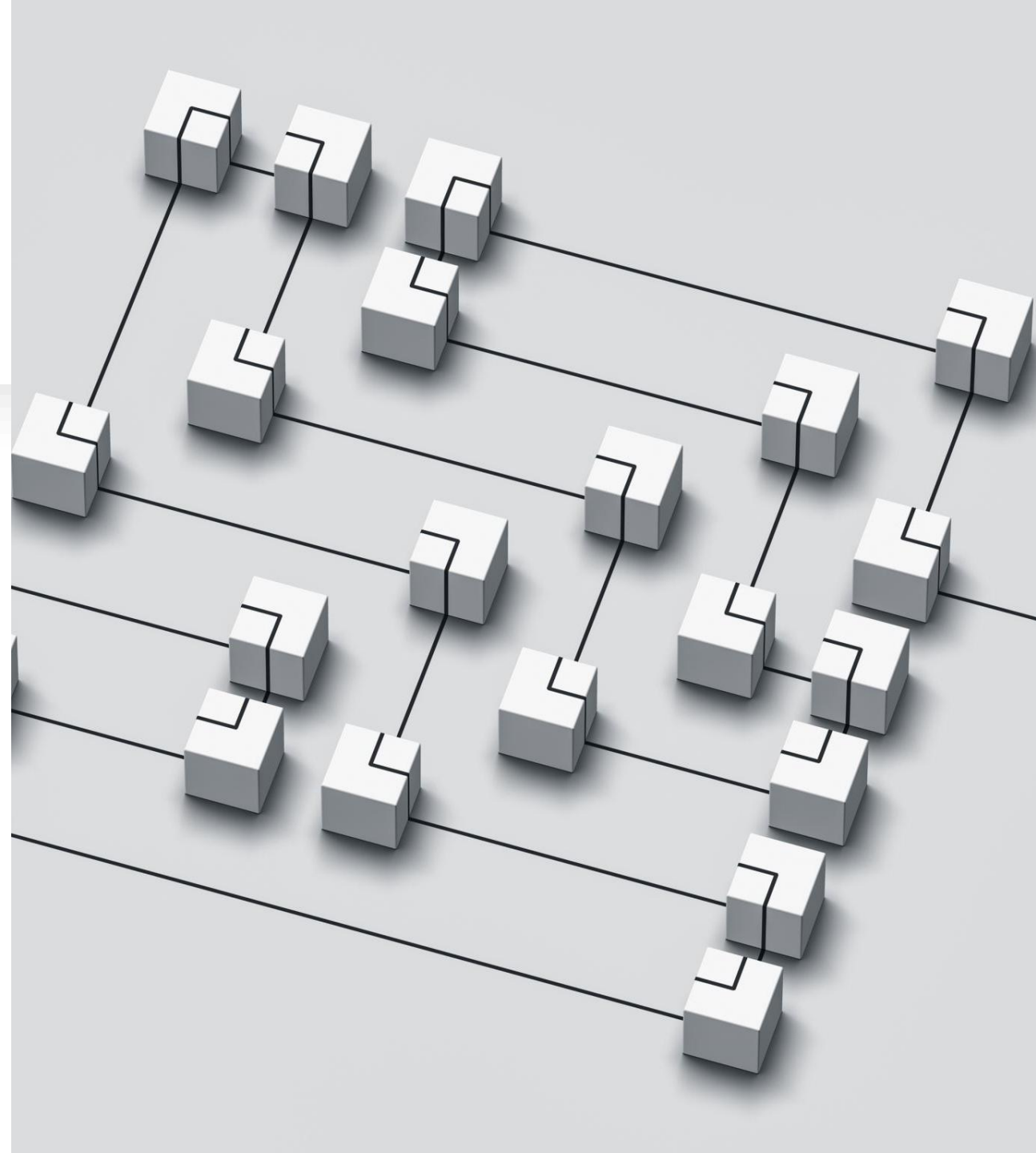


Requirements Cross Reference

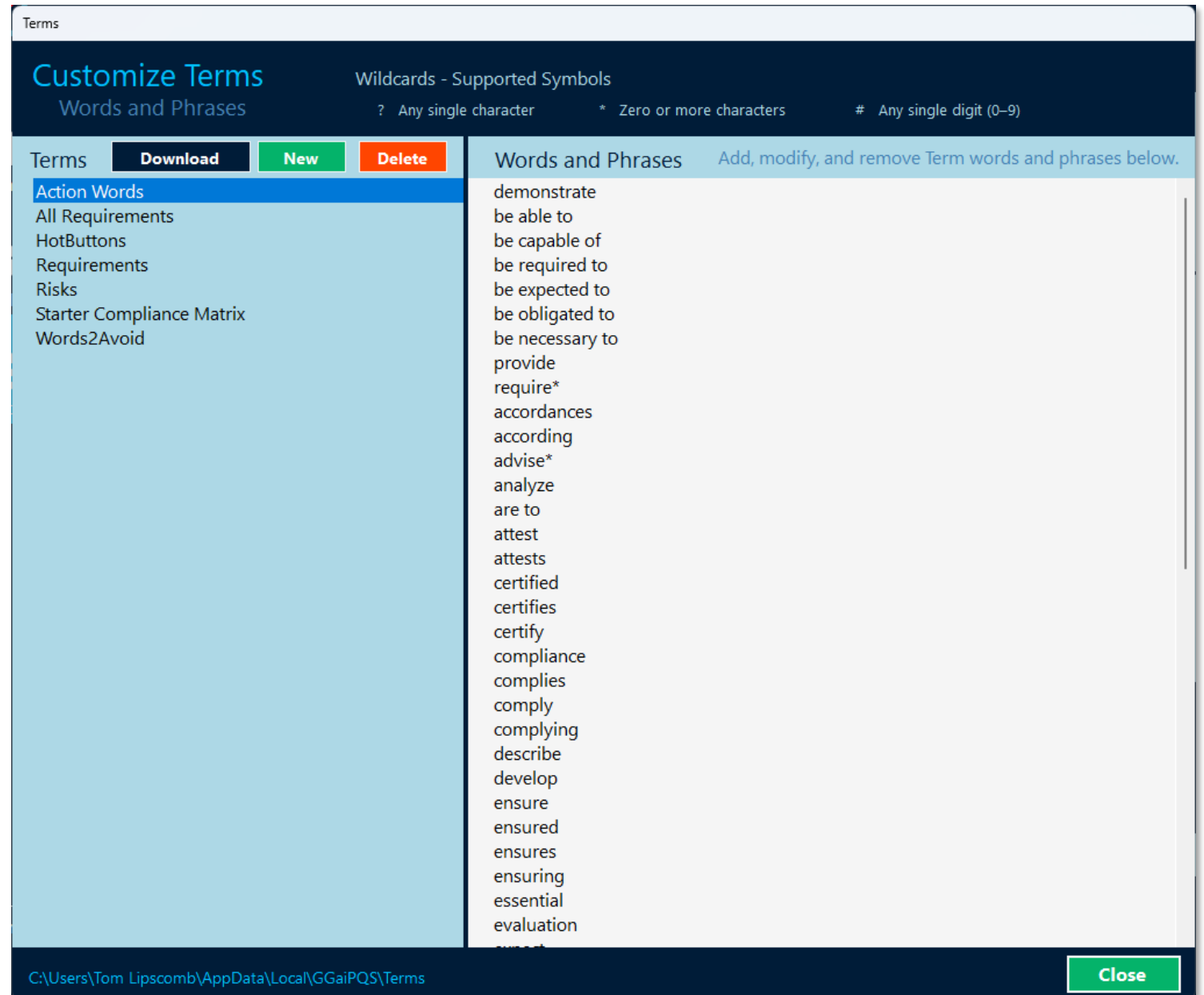

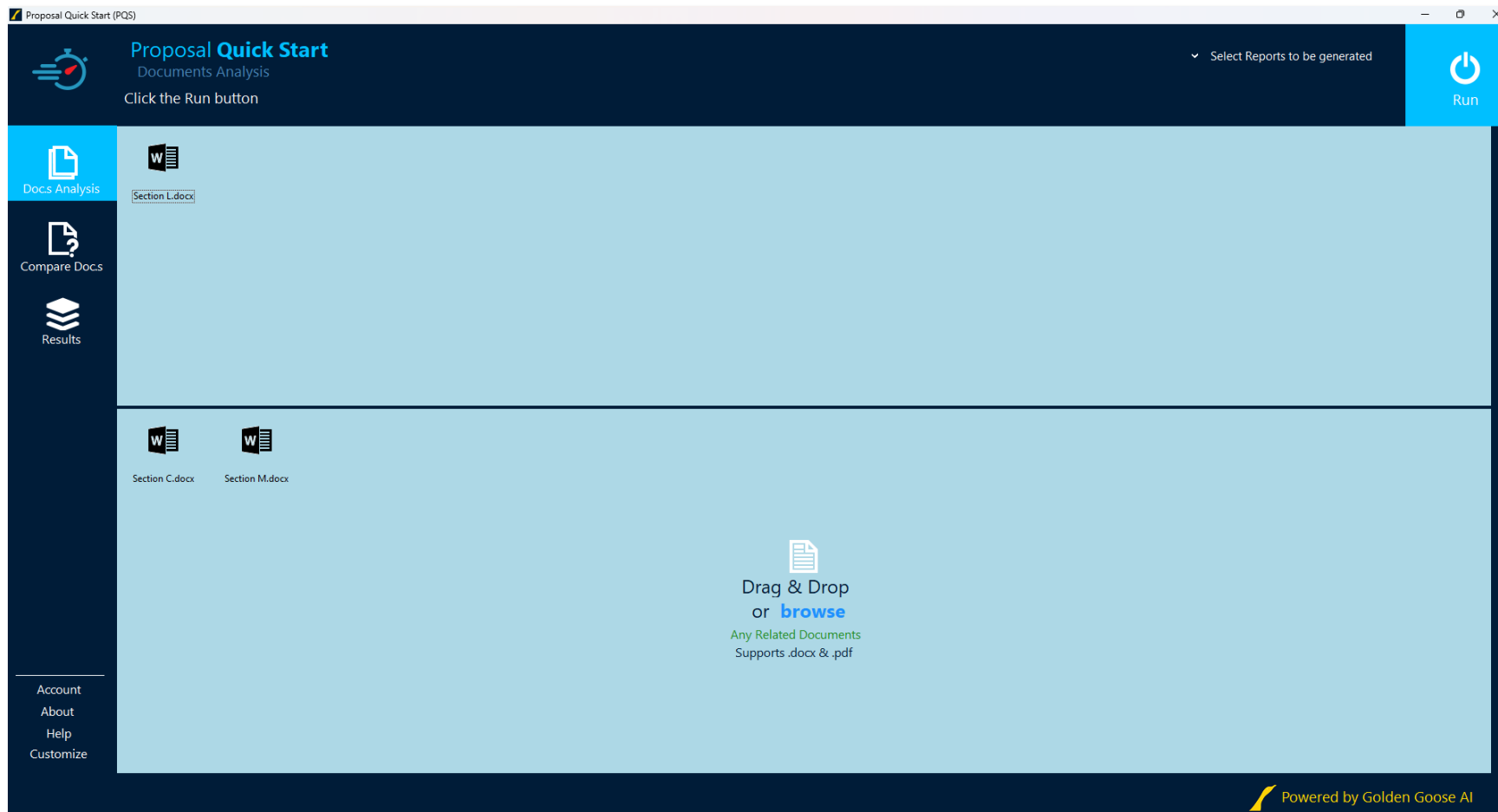
